<p>Factories declined in Telangana</p>	<p>Context: As per report:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A decline in the number of factories in Telangana has been witnessed • The 10,635 factories in the state employed a total of 6,56,397 workers in the financial year 2019-20. • The non-value added (NVA) activity of these factories during this period was Rs 49,232 crore.

<p>Crimes against children surge in Hyderabad</p>  <p>National Crime Records Bureau</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hyderabad has been witnessing a surge in crimes against children, even when police are taking stringent measures • The National Crime Records Bureau data shows that in 2020, as many as 467 crimes against children were reported. • In 2021, the crimes saw a jump to 621 and stood at 645 by 2022.
