Thousand-Pillared Mandapam



Context:

- The Thousand-Pillared Mandapam is also known as the Aayiram Kaal Mandapam or Rudreswara Swamy temple
- It is located in Warangal, Andhra Pradesh
- It was built during the Kakatiya dynasty in the 12th century,
- The temple was commissioned by King Rudra Deva
- It was originally dedicated to Lord Shiva but later became a multi-religious space.
- The mandapam of the temple is built in the Kakatiya architectural style, characterized by intricate carvings, star-shaped layouts, and pyramidal towers.
- The hall itself is supported by a staggering 1000 pillars, each with unique sculptures depicting various deities, mythical creatures, and scenes from everyday life.
