<p>Aadhaar Must for Telangana Govt's Six Guarantee Benefits</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Telangana government has made Aadhaar mandatory for availing six key welfare schemes under their 'Six Guarantee Benefits' program. • This means that beneficiaries must link their Aadhaar card with their ration card, pension scheme, Rythu Bandhu (farmer assistance), Arogyasri (health insurance), Kalyana Lakshmi (marriage assistance), and Kanti Velugu (free spectacles) to receive these benefits.
