Indian Navy unveils new epaulettes for admirals	 Context The Navy unveiled the new design of epaulettes for admirals, with the octagon in the new design drawn from the naval ensign and inspired by rajmudra of Chhatrapati Shivaji. The new design is a "true reflection of our rich maritime heritage" and reiterates the "resolve to do away with Ghulami ki Maansikta". The new epaulettes have the golden Navy button top, followed by an octagon, an Indian sword and a telescope crossed, followed by stars indicating the ranks.
<section-header></section-header>	 Context The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) will launch PSLV-C58 X-ray Polarimeter Satellite (XPoSat) mission. Key points XPoSat is the first dedicated scientific satellite from ISRO to carry out research in space-based polarisation measurements of X-ray emission from celestial sources. It carries two payloads — POLIX (Polarimeter Instrument in X-rays) and XSPECT (X-ray Spectroscopy and Timing). POLIX has been developed by the Raman Research Institute and XSPECT is by the Space Astronomy Group of URSC, Bengaluru.
Lithium deal with Argentina	 Context The Mines Ministry, through the state-owned Khanij Bidesh India Ltd (KABIL), has entered into a draft exploration and development agreement with Argentinan miner CAMYEN for possible acquisition and development of five-odd lithium blocks. The company has also entered into a non-disclosure agreement with Chilean miner ENAMI for 'possible exploration,






