Asian Waterbird Census 2024



Context:

- The **Asian Waterbird Census-2024** is scheduled to **commence on January 5**.
- It will cover 12 migratory bird habitats, including wetlands, mangroves, lagoons and swamps, in the Godavari estuary and its adjoining areas in Andhra Pradesh.
- A majority of the area to be covered in the two-day census falls within the Coringa Wildlife Sanctuary.
