APSRTC to cut costs by installing solar plants in AP	 Context: Andhra Pradesh State Road Transport Corporation (APSRTC) plans to install solar panels on the rooftops of bus stations, depots, and other facilities across the state. This initiative holds immense potential, promising both environmental and economic benefits. The green initiative of the Central Government, the APSRTC had installed four rooftop solar plants of 100 Kwp capacity each in 2019 at Madanapalle, Kakinada, Nandyal and Chittoor
