World Wildlife Fund identified 26 prioritized wetlands in AP	 The World Wildlife Fund (WWF) has identified 26 wetlands in AP as requiring urgent conservation action. This list was submitted to the State Wetland Authority for necessary action. These wetlands are crucial for maintaining biodiversity, providing habitat for various species, and supporting local communities. Some key wetlands on the list include the Coringa Sanctuary, Kondakarla Ava, Telineelapuram, Telikunchi, Uppalapadu, and Punyakshetram. The Andhra Pradesh government is exploring Ramsar status for the Coringa Sanctuary, indicating its international importance. Conservation efforts are underway for several wetlands, including Godavari and Krishna estuaries, known for their rich bird and animal life.
AP government to organise National Skill Conclave in Visakhapatnam	 The Andhra Pradesh government, under the leadership of Finance, Skill Development, and Training Minister Buggana Rajendranath, is organizing the National Skill Conclave in Visakhapatnam on February 9, 2024. This event aims to promote the state's skill development ecosystem at the national level, showcasing its successful initiatives in bridging the skill gap and providing skilled workers to industries. It will serve as a platform for insightful discussions and collaborative partnerships among key stakeholders - government, academia, and industry leaders. The conclave hopes to foster collective efforts to address the evolving skill demands of Industry 4.0 and develop relevant skill development programs.









Edinburgh University experts laud	Concept:
Andhra Pradesh's natural farming initiatives	 A team of professors and experts from the University of Edinburgh, United Kingdom visited Palnadu district and explored natural farming fields. The delegation interacted with the farmers and representatives of womens' groups, seeking insights into their role in the implementation of the natural farming initiatives. They visited paddy fields, chili fields, papaya fields, and inquired about investment and profit involved in natural farming. Rythu Sadhikara Samstha representatives (RySS) explained various methods of farming practiced by farmers under Andhra Pradesh Community Managed Natural Farming (APCNF) project. Lauding the State government and RySS initiatives, the delegate said that natural farming not only benefits the farmers by fetching them more profits but also benefits the consumers by providing chemical-free food, and helps to improve both soil health and ecosystem.
Third railway line between Khurda Road and Vijayanagaram	 Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnav revealed that the government has approved the construction of the third railway line between Odisha's Khurda Road and Vizianagaram in AP The third line between Nergundi-Barang and Khurda Road-Vizianagaram with a length of 385 km on the Howrah-Chennai mail line is estimated to cost Rs 5,618 crore. Around 184 km of the new line will pass through Bhadrak, Jajpur, Khurda, Cuttack and Ganjam districts while the remaining 201 km will cover three districts in Andhra Pradesh
"Nethanna Nestham" helping in the financial uplift of handloom weavers in A.P.	The YSR Nethanna Nestham scheme was launched in December 2019 by the Andhra Pradesh government It aims to financially empower handloom weavers in the state.
