State Abbreviation Change to 'TG'

Context:

- The Telangana government, under the leadership of Chief Minister A. Revanth Reddy, has decided to change the state's abbreviation from 'TS' to 'TG'.
- This decision, made during a state Cabinet meeting, aims to replace 'TS' with 'TG' in official documents and gazettes of the Union government.

Other significant changes:

- The Cabinet also decided to change Telangana Talli statue to reflect the sentiments of Telangana people.
- It decided to adopt Andesri's "Jai Jai Ho Telangana" as the state song. It was also decided to design a new state emblem in consultation with all stakeholders.

International Day of Zero Tolerance for Female Genital Mutilation



- The International Day of Zero Tolerance for female genital mutilation (FGM) is observed annually on 6 February.
- This provides an opportunity for all stakeholders involved in ending FGM to celebrate achievements, advocate for abandonment of the practice and raise awareness.
- 2024 Theme: Her Voice. Her Future
- This year marks the 13th anniversary of this international day.
- In 2024, nearly 4.4 million girls or more than 12,000 each day are at risk of FGM around the world.

Solar Power Generation in Telugu States

Context:

 Telangana and Andhra Pradesh are leading in solar power generation in India, with Telangana ranking sixth and Andhra Pradesh seventh in cumulative solar capacity.

Key Solar power projects:

- In 2021, Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited (BHEL) commissioned India's largest floating Solar PV plant in Andhra Pradesh.
- However, in 2022, Telangana surpassed this with the country's largest floating solar power project in Ramagundam -100 MW established by NTPC.









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	 Telangana ranks fourth in solar power production and second in solar power capacity per unit area in India. The state aims to add 3 GW of clean energy capacity in 4-5 years and promotes solar adoption through incentives like single-window clearances and tax exemptions. The solar potential in the state is estimated at 20.41 GW. Telangana's government, through TS-iPASS, guarantees industrial approvals within 15 days, encouraging investment and development in the renewable energy sector.

	 Telangana Super Thermal Power Project (TSTPP) aimed at a total power generation capacity of 1,600 MW (2x800 MW each) in the first phase, with a planned total capacity of 4,000 MW near
	 Ramagundam village in Karimnagar district. National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) confirmed that Telangana Unit 2 reached its full load capacity of 800 MW on Saturday.
	 The first 800 MW first unit was dedicated to the nation by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on 3 October, 2023.
	Key features of the plant:
	This plant has several environment-friendly fuel-efficient features with an improved cycle efficiency of 42 per cent, a unified control system and control room, gas insulated substation, installation of roof-top solar panels on all plant buildings, highly concentration slurry disposal system for water conservation and flue gas desulphurisation (FGD) for SOX reduction.
