CAG points out lapses in the execution of Veligonda project	<ul> <li>Context:</li> <li>The Poola Subbaiah Veligonda Project (PSVGP) is aimed to provide irrigation and drinking water to drought-prone areas in Andhra Pradesh.</li> <li>However, the Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG) report identified several concerns in its execution.</li> </ul>	
	<ul> <li>Key Lapses:</li> <li>Financial Irregularities: Schedule of payments were approved with inflated values for certain works, exceeding agreed rates.</li> <li>Planning Deficiencies: Issues were found in the planning of tunnels, reservoir, canal network, and distributaries. For example, tunnel capacity exceeding feeder canal capacity could hinder achieving the intended irrigation area.</li> <li>Execution Delays: The project, initially planned for completion within five years, remains unfinished, leading to cost overruns and missed benefits.</li> </ul>	
Rs 96.34 crore released for land acquisition in Ongole	<ul> <li>Context:</li> <li>The State government has released Rs 96.34 crore, bringing the total to Rs 126.34 crore, for land acquisition to provide house sites for approximately 24,000 beneficiaries of the housing scheme within Ongole city limits.</li> <li>The Prakasam district authorities transferred the funds directly into the bank accounts of 236 farmers, who offered 435 acres of agriculture land for the scheme in Malleswara Puram, N Agraharam, Yarajarla, and Vengamukkala Palem villages under Ongole rural mandal jurisdiction.</li> <li>Recently, under the State government directives, Prakasam district Collector AS Dinesh Kumar has released Rs 30 crore, totalling 126.34 crore, benefitting 236 out of 270 farmers.</li> </ul>


