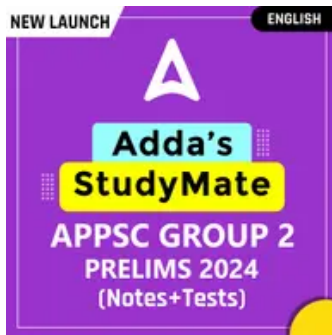

<p>Manyam district credit plan set at ₹4,000 crore</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The National Bank for Agriculture and Rural Development (NABARD) launched the potential linked credit plan (PLP) for Parvathipuram-Manyam district with an estimate of 4,000 crore for 2024-25 financial year. • Of this amount, farm credit is estimated at 2,900 crore.
<p>Andhra got more water share after T formed</p>	<p>Context:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Irrigation minister N Uttam Kumar Reddy said that Andhra Pradesh got more share in Krishna water after Telangana was bifurcated from the erstwhile state. • He said that, Telangana has 68% of Krishna basin area but after bifurcation, the water share was reduced to 38% as previous BRS govt agreed with AP's proposal.
