Context: A recent discovery in Andhra Pradesh revealed a replica of a rare 15th century palm leaf manuscript. This replica, made on 150-year-old handmade paper, was found in Kadiri, Sri Sathya Sai district. About:
	 The original manuscript, dating back to 1474 CE, contained details about the Sri Veeranjaneya Swamy temple at Palapati Dinna. It consisted of two thick palm leaves stored in a bamboo box. Additionally, another replica, the "Siva Prasasti," was found. This large document featured verses about Lord Shiva and contained images of deities and mentions of nearby temples.
