Handri Neeva Sujala Sravanthi project

Context:

- Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy on Monday inaugurated the Kuppam Branch Canal of the Handri Neeva Sujala Sravanthi project and released Krishna waters for the Kuppam and Palamaner Assembly constituencies.
- The canal has been constructed at a cost of ₹560.29 crore.
- This project aims to provide irrigation water to over 6,300 acres of land in the Kuppam and Palamaner constituencies.
- The canal, constructed under Phase II in Rama Kuppam mandal, will channel Krishna river water to 110 minor irrigation tanks in the region.
- This initiative is expected to improve agricultural productivity and benefit farmers in the area.

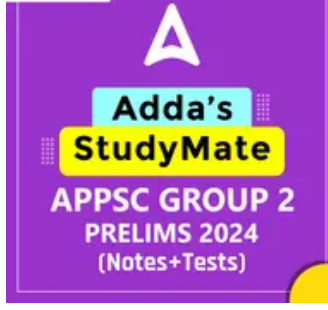
