| | A report indicates Hyderabad as one of the Indian cities with the highest housing price increase in 2023. While ranking fourth behind Bengaluru, Delhi NCR, and Kolkata in overall average price rise compared to 2021, Hyderabad witnessed significant growth, reaching an average price of ₹11,083 per sq ft in the fourth quarter of 2023. This marks a substantial jump from ₹8,821 per sq ft in 2021 and ₹10,090 per sq ft in 2022.
