| Telangana lost ₹157 crore to cyber criminals in February | Telangana witnessed a surge in cybercrime in February 2024, resulting in a collective loss of ₹157 crore to its citizens. The Telangana State Cyber Security Bureau (TSCSB) received reports of over 9,600 cybercrimes, with a staggering 8,088 involving financial fraud. These financial frauds, primarily identity theft and card-related scams, exploited tactics like fake customer care services, card blocking ruses, and KYC updates to deceive victims. The top five methods used by cybercriminals resulted in losses exceeding ₹119 crore, with only a small portion currently frozen. |

| Telangana's annual debt surpasses budget estimates | Telangana's annual debt has exceeded its budget estimates by a wide margin for the first time in recent years, standing at Rs.40,852.51 crore as of January this fiscal year as against the budget estimation of Rs.38,234.94 crore for the entire financial year. The borrowings for current year have overshot the budget estimations by 6.85 per cent. |
