Pandavula Gutta designated exclusive Geo-heritage site in Telangana'	 Context: Pandavula Gutta, a geological wonder predating the Himalayas, has been designated Telangana's sole Geo-heritage site. This recognition highlights the region's unique geological significance. About: The announcement coincides with India's Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav celebrations. Foundation stone laid for 9-km canal from Sitarama Lift Irrigation Project

- Context: • The foundation stone for a 9-kilometer canal was laid. The canal will connect the Sitarama Lift Irrigation Project to the Wyra reservoir. This project is expected to provide both drinking water and irrigation benefits. Wyra Reservoir: The Wyra Reservoir, located in Khammam District, Telangana, is a medium irrigation project built on the Wyra River, a tributary of the Krishna River. Constructed in 1930 and inaugurated by Dr. • Sarvepalli Radhakrishnan, it serves multiple purposes for the region. **Irrigation:** The reservoir irrigates a significant area • of land, around 17,391 acres, vital for agriculture in the region. Drinking water: Wyra Reservoir supplies drinking water to eight mandals (administrative units) around Wyra. Tourism: The scenic beauty of the reservoir with
 - its green hills around it makes it a popular tourist attraction in Khammam. The area is also known for good fishing.
