Context:

- World Oral Health Day is observed annually on March 20th
- This day raises awareness about the critical role oral hygiene plays in overall health.
- This day aims to empower individuals with the knowledge and tools to maintain good oral health through:
- Brushing and flossing regularly
- Limiting sugary drinks and unhealthy foods
- Scheduling regular dental checkups

Theme:

- The 2024 theme is "A Happy Mouth is a Happy Body"
- It emphasizes the connection between oral health and well-being.

APMB lead the blue economy revolution in Andhra Pradesh

Context:

 Andhra Pradesh Maritime Board (APMB) spearheads the blue economy revolution in Andhra Pradesh, aiming to leverage the state's abundant marine resources and extensive coastline.

Blue Economy Development:

- Government is developing nine fishing harbours on a fast-track basis with an investment exceeding Rs. 3,600 crore.
- AP's 974-kilometer coastline, the second longest in India, has the potential to create a US\$20 billion blue economy by 2035.
- Advantageous coastal areas with serene, deep waters close to the shore contribute to this

potential.

Well-connected rail network and national highways near the coast enhance growth prospects.

Port Infrastructure:

- Gangavaram Port, Krishnapatnam Port. Kakinada Port, Kakinada Deep Water Anchorage Port, and Rawa Port are the five non-major operational ports.
- Visakhapatnam is the major operational port.
- Development of three greenfield ports at Ramayapatnam, Machilipatnam, and Mulapeta is underway, along with the Kakinada Gateway Port (SEZ) under the PPP model.
- These developments, with a combined investment of approximately INR 16,000 crores, are expected to generate 110 MTPA additional capacity by 2025–26, creating over 75,000 job opportunities.

Maritime Industries:

- AP fosters private participation various maritime-related sectors.
- Industries include food processing, cold storage, shipbuilding, repair, Free Trade Warehousing Zones (FTWZs), LNG terminals, and maritime tourism.
- Green energy initiatives like green hydrogen. coastal and floating solar parks, offshore wind farms, and tidal energy projects are also promoted.

Fisheries Sector:

- AP is the largest fish-producing state in India, with over 4.8 million tonnes annually and a 30% share.
- 555 fishery villages with a population of 6.3 lakh fishermen are located along the coastline.
- Government developing nine fishing harbours to further capitalize on marine reserves and the coastline.

Economic Impact:

- Investments in Andhra Pradesh accelerate port-led economic arowth and industrialization. enhancing transportation infrastructure and revenue streams.
- They attract new industries and SEZs, leading to greater FDI, export growth, and job creation, ultimately fostering the state's prosperity.
