Telangana braces for massive pollen tsunami	 Telangana is bracing for a rise in respiratory issues due to a large-scale tree felling operation in the Damagundam forest. The deforestation, meant to make way for a military project, could cause a "pollen tsunami" as millions of trees release pollen at once. Experts warn this could exacerbate allergies and asthma, posing a significant public health threat. Pulmonologists have voiced concerns to the National Green Tribunal, highlighting the potential environmental and health risks of the project.
Hyderabad sees record 45% spike in aerosols in 20 years: Study	 A recent study has revealed a significant increase in aerosol levels in Hyderabad over the past two decades. The study reports a rise of 45% in aerosol concentration, which is a cause for concern. About: Aerosols are tiny particles, either solid or liquid, suspended in air. They can be natural or man-made, and play a significant role in Earth's climate, weather, and health. Types: Natural aerosols include fog, dust, volcanic ash, and sea spray. Man-made aerosols come from sources like burning fossil fuels, spraying aerosols, and industrial processes.
TIFR-Hyderabad researchers come up with durable lithium metal battery	 Researchers at TIFR-Hyderabad have created a promising method for building safer and longer-lasting lithium metal batteries (LMBs). LMBs are seen as a future technology for energy storage due to their potential to hold ten times more energy than current lithium-ion batteries. A major hurdle for LMBs is the growth of dendrites, mossy lithium deposits that can cause short circuits. TIFR-Hyderabad's approach involves modifying the battery's separator membrane, a critical component that keeps the electrodes apart, using a common and affordable graphite-based material.
