This theme emphasizes the importance of ensuring everyone, everywhere has access to healthcare services, information, and education to live a healthy life.

IMA-A.P. releases 'Health Manifesto' for equal access to healthcare	 Context: The Indian Medical Association's Andhra Pradesh chapter (IMA-A.P.) released a "Health Manifesto" on April 6th, 2024. This manifesto highlights existing gaps in the state's healthcare system and proposes measures to ensure everyone has equal access to quality care. About: The first in the manifesto is Universal Health Care which should be an entitled provision in the basic health package of every citizen. The government should not only provide appropriate medical care but also address all the health determinants, including drinking water and sanitation. The IMA demanded that the minimum allocation for health, which at present varies from 1.1 to 1.6% of GDP, one of the lowest in the world, should be increased to 2.5% AMR threat Highlighting that Antimicrobial Resistance is an emerging threat in communicable diseases, the IMA members said it has to be tackled with urgency. The responsible use of antibiotics is a fundamental and effective strategy in containing AMR. The members also advocated the revival of the Indian Medical Services, which was discontinued in 1948, to address the issue of paucity of professionalism in health management.
