NAREDCO	 Context: Sandeep Mandava, CEO of Malaxmi Group, has taken charge as the new president of the Central Zone of NAREDCO(National Real Estate Development Council) About: Established in 1998 under the purview of the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs of the Government of India, the National Real Estate Development Council (NAREDCO) stands as the foremost industry association within the nation's real estate sector. Its principal aim is to establish an official forum where governmental entities, real estate stakeholders, and the general populace can converge to discuss and resolve the challenges prevalent in the sector. This app enables the tracking of patrolling units and police officers on poll duty, providing real-time updates about the ground situation at over 1,500 polling stations in the district. About: The app's key feature is the 'SOS' button, which can be used to alert security personnel, special striking parties, and mobile parties in case of violence or other emergencies at polling booths. These alerts are sent instantly, and with the help of Google Maps, the nearest

Furthermore, the app enables the dissemination of important information and notifications to over 2,000 police personnel, even in areas with no internet connectivity. It provides access to election rules, laws, training materials, and directives from the Election Commission of India (ECI) and police authorities at any time.
Alluri Sitaramaraju District	 Context: In the hilltop villages of ASR district, Andhra Pradesh, basic amenities remain a distant dream for the tribals, who lament the lack of proper roads, reliable drinking water sources, and schools. Key points: Alluri Sitharama Raju District is one of the North Eastern district of Andhra Pradesh. It is bounded on the North partly by the Odisha State Partly by Chattisgarh State and partly by Telangana State on the South by Anakapalli, Kakinada and East Godavari Districts on the West covered by Godavari River and East by Vijayanagaram District. The headquarters of the district is located at Paderu. The tribals who live in the area are: Konda Dora, Khond, Konda Reddy, Konda Kapu, Koya, Parang Proja, Valmiki. This district is named after Alluri Sitarama Raju, a revolutionary in the Indian independence movement who came from the region.
