In April 2024, energy demand ranged from 235 to 245 MU per day and reached 6,345 MU by April 26, with a peak of 253 MU on April 19, 2024. Key findings: Energy distribution in April: 45.7% from APGENCO (Thermal, Hydel), 15.27% from Non-Conventional sources (wind and solar), 15.16% from CGS, and 23.87% from IPPs, market purchases, gas, etc. APGENCO is maintaining required coal stocks at thermal

About: Kallakuri Narayana Rao (1871-1927) was a distinguished social reformer, playwright, cinematographer, and Indian nationalist from Andhra Pradesh. As a playwright, Narayana Rao penned several famous plays, including "Varavikrayam," "Chintamani," "Madhuseva," "Chintamani," inghlighted social issues like the hazards of harlotry, while "Padmavyuham" used historical and mythological frameworks to critique British domination in India. His novel "Varavikrayam" addressed the dowry system prevalent in British India. Narayana Rao's contributions as a social reformer and writer earned him the honorific title "Mahakavi," meaning "great poet."
