Land Tilting Act	Context: • The AP Land Titling Act of 2023 has sparked a political storm in Andhra Pradesh, becoming a focal point for discussion and controversy.
	 About: Passed in August 2022 by the YSRCP government. Aims to create a system for clear land ownership records and a central database. Establishes tribunals for faster dispute resolution.
	 Key Points: Requires mandatory registration of all land/immovable property with the government. Issues permanent titles after verification based on new land surveys. Restricts civil courts from handling land disputes arising under the Act (This has been challenged in High Court).
	 Potential Benefits: Clearer land titles can ease property transactions and access to credit. Faster dispute resolution through tribunals.
	 Controversies: Opposition argues it could lead to more disputes and be misused for land acquisition. Lawyers have challenged the restriction on civil courts hearing land dispute cases.
	 Current Status: Andhra Pradesh High Court recently ruled that civil courts can hear land disputes but did not repeal the Act.
