About Karimnagar Filigree:  • Karimnagar silver filigree involves creating beautiful objects using thin silver wires.  • The craft is believed to be dating back to the 19th century, and may have been influenced by Persian artisans.  • The Nizams of Hyderabad were patrons of this art form.  GI Status:  • Karimnagar silver filigree was awarded Geographical Indication (GI) status in 2007.
TSRTC is now TGSRTC	Context:  • The Telangana State Road Transport Corporation (TSRTC) has been renamed TGSRTC.  • This change aligns with the Telangana state government's directive to use "TG" as the official abbreviation.  • The TGSRTC logo will also be updated.  Fact:  • It was after the bifurcation of the State in 2014, the then APSRTC was bifurcated and TSRTC was formed.
Yenkathala grasslands to get BHS tag	Context:  • The Yenkathala grasslands in Vikarabad district are being considered for the Biodiversity Heritage Site (BHS) tag.  • It is a haven for resident and migratory birds  About:  • This designation would provide legal protection to the area, similar to reserved forests.  • It would mean that the site will be protected by

Address concerns of all industries, especially MSMEs.</li> <li>b. Streamline the incentive disbursement process.</li> <li>c. Make Telangana more competitive in attracting new industries.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Six new sub-policies are also being formulated alongside the main industrial policy, focusing on: <ul> <li>1. Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs)</li> <li>2. Exports</li> <li>3. Life Sciences</li> <li>4. Electric Vehicles (revised policy)</li> <li>5. Medical Tourism</li> <li>6. Transco fined Rs 50 lakh by NGT for deviating from project	Context:  • TS Transmission Corporation of Telangana Limited (TSTRANSCO) was penalized Rs 50 lakh by the National Green Tribunal (NGT) for altering an approved project.
	The original plan involved installing monopoles for a power transmission line through protected areas.     TSTRANSCO instead constructed high voltage quad towers in the Mrugavani National Park and Chilkur Reserve Forest.
