

| New EO OI IID | The new government in Andhra Pradesh has made changes in the administration of the Tirumala Tirupati Devasthanams (TTD), appointing IAS Officer J Syamala Rao as the new Executive Officer. |
| | Key points: Rao, a 1997 batch IAS officer, replaces AV Dharma Reddy. The notification was issued by the General Administration (SC.A) Department on June 14, relieving the senior Indian Defence Estates Service (IDES) officer from his additional charge as the TTD Executive Officer. Syamala Rao has previously served as Visakhapatnam district collector. |

| | Key points: The ICG aims to investigate the prevention and control of diseases such as Malaria, Dengue, Lymphatic Filariasis, Japanese Encephalitis, and Chikungunya. Vector-borne diseases are illnesses that are transmitted by vectors, which include mosquitoes, ticks, and fleas. These vectors can carry infective pathogens such as viruses, bacteria, and protozoa, which can be transferred from one host (carrier) to another. |

| | Key points: • Chief Minister Naidu retained the General Administration Department (GAD), Public Enterprises, and any other unallocated portfolios. |

- Jana Sena Party (JSP) president Pawan Kalyan was appointed Deputy Chief Minister.
 - He received key departments such as Panchayat Raj and Rural Development (PR&RD). Rural Water Supply, **Environment.** Science. Forest. and Technology.
- Nara Lokesh, Naidu's son and Mangalagiri MLA, was entrusted with Human Resources Development, IT, Electronics and Communication, and Real Time Governance.
 - 0 Lokesh had previously managed Electronics and Communication, and PR&RD in his earlier tenure as TDP general secretary.
- Senior leader Payyavula Keshav was given charge of Finance, Planning, Commercial Taxes, and Legislative Affairs.
- A surprising allocation was made with Vangalapudi Anitha being given the Home portfolio.
- Anagani Satya Prasad, a first-time Minister, was assigned the Revenue, Registration, and Stamps portfolio.
- **TDP** senior leader K Atchannaidu received Agriculture, Cooperation, Marketing. Animal Husbandry, Dairy Development, and Fisheries.
- Senior leader Anam Ramanarayana Reddy was allocated the Endowments portfolio
- Gottipati Ravi Kumar (Energy), Nimmala Rama Naidu (Water Resources), BC Janardhan Reddy Infrastructure (Roads and Buildings, Investments). TG **Bharat** (Industries and Commerce, Food Processing), K Srinivas (MSME, SERP, NRI Empowerment, Insurance Medical).
- Satya Kumar Yadav, the lone BJP MLA in the Cabinet, was allocated Health, Family Welfare, and Medical Education.
- From the JSP, Nadendla Manohar received the Food and Civil Supplies, Consumer Affairs portfolio, and Kandula Durgesh was assigned Tourism, Culture, and Cinematography. Kollu Ravindra was given Mines and Geology, and Excise portfolios, marking his return as Excise Minister.
- In a bid to further develop Amaravati, Naidu once again allocated Municipal Administration and Urban Development to P Narayana.
- Other notable allocations include K Parthasarathy (Housing, Information and Public Relations), NMD Faroog (Law & Justice, Minority Welfare), Dola Bala Veeranjaneya Swamy (Social Welfare, Disabled and Senior Citizens Welfare, Sachivalayam and Village




