- The Pro-tem Speaker presides over the first sitting of the Lok Sabha, administers the oath of office to the newly elected MPs.

Why in news?

The marine cargo exports from Visakhapatnam port ranked highest among all the ports in the country accounting for almost 29.7% of the total marine cargo exports of the country in the year 2023 - 2024.

About:

- Visakhapatnam Port, also known as Vizag Port, is situated in Visakhapatnam city, Andhra Pradesh.
- It is a **natural harbor** and one of India's **oldest ports**, known for its depth and safety.
- It's the second largest in the country for cargo handling and consists of three harbors: inner, outer, and fishing.

Mahatma Gandhi National Rural **Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA)**

Why in news?

- During Covid-19 pandemic which was fuelled by various stages of lockdown, the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA) generated around 25.9 crore person-days marking the highest in Andhra Pradesh's history.
- The year 2023-24, recorded around 25.5 crore person-days, ranking as second highest for Andhra Pradesh.





Key Points:

- MGNREGA is the abbreviation for the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act 2005 that guarantees the "right to work" to rural citizens of India.
- Under this, the government assures a minimum of 100 days of unskilled manual work to an adult member of an eligible rural household.
- The objective is to provide employment to rural citizens and improve their economic conditions.
- **Eligibility Criteria:**
 - Citizen of India
 - 18 years of age at the time of application
 - Rural Household
 - Willing to do unskilled work
