Why in news?

 Ramesh Karthik Nayak from Telangana Nizamabad has become the first and youngest tribal writer to win the Kendra Sahitya Akademi Yuva Puraskar 2024 for his collection of short stories "Dhavlo" (Song of Lament).

Key points:

- Sahitya Akademi, India's National Academy of Letters, is the central institution for literary dialogue, publication and promotion in the country and the only institution that undertakes literary activities in 24 Indian languages, including English.
- It was registered as a society under the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

Species in News: Indian Painted Frog



Why in news?

 A rare Indian Painted Frog has been spotted at the Kawal Tiger Reserve in Telangana.

Key points:

- The Indian Painted Frog, also known as **Kaloula pulchra**, is a small, unique amphibian that is part of the Microhylidae family.
- It is notable for its striking appearance, characterized by its rounded body and distinctive colouration which includes shades of brown, orange or yellow.
- Key Habitats: Sri Lanka, Bangladesh, and western parts of India.
- The International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) has rated its species as **'least concern'**.

Places in news: Bogatha waterfall



Why in news?

- The Wazeedu Forest authorities have started allowing tourists to visit the Bogatha waterfall which is in Mulugu district, Telangana.
- Bogatha is called the "Telangana Niagara" and "Telangana Niagara jalapatham".

Irrigation **Project** Kaleshwaram Lift (KLIP)



Why in news?

The Central Water and Power Research Station (CWPRS) has carried out investigations on the Annaram and Sundilla barrages of the Kaleshwaram Lift Irrigation Project (KLIP).

Key points:

- KLIP is a multipurpose irrigation project on the Godavari River, at Kaleshwaram village in Telangana.
- It is aimed at supplying water to 45 lakh acres in Telangana.
- It was previously known as the Pranahita-Chevella Lift Irrigation Project.
- It is the world's largest multi-stage and multi-purpose lift irrigation project.
- Key Barrages: Medigadda, Annaram and Sundilla.

AP government requests DoPT to return IAS officers from Telangana

Why in news?

Andhra Pradesh government requests Department of Personnel and Training (DoPT) to return IAS officers from Telangana.

About DoPT:

- The Department of Personnel & Training (DoPT) is the coordinating agency of the Central Government in personnel matters especially in respect of issues concerning
- recruitments.
- It comes under the Ministry of Personnel Public Grievances and Pensions which comprises of three departments,
 - Department of Personnel and Training the Department of Pensions and Pensioners Welfare
 - Department of Administrative Reforms
 - Public Grievances
- has the cadre controlling authority for the Indian Administrative Service (IAS) officers and the three Secretariat Services in the Central Secretariat.
