Dengue	 Why in news? Telangana is among the states in India most affected by dengue with all four stereotypes of the virus being observed.
	 Key Points: Dengue is a mosquito-borne tropical disease caused by the dengue virus (Genus Flavivirus), transmitted by several species of female mosquitos. It spreads through the bite of two mosquitoes - Aedes aegypti and Aedes albopictus. DEN-1, DEN-2, DEN-3 and DEN-4 are four distinct serotypes that cause dengue. Symptoms - Sudden high fever, severe headaches, pain behind the eyes, severe bone, joint, and muscle pain, etc. There is no specific medicine to treat dengue infection.
Telangana-Odisha rail line	 Why in news? A new railway line between Telangana and Odisha will pass through the Maoist-affected districts of Dantewada and Sukma in Chhattisgarh for the first time. The 186-km new railway line will start from Pandurangapuram, Bhadrachalam in Telangana and culminate at Malkangiri in Odisha, while passing through the Naxal belt.
Places in News: Green Skills Academy	 Why in news? The 1M1B (One Million for One Billion) Foundation and Salesforce have set up the first physical center of 1M1BGreen Skills Academy in Hyderabad. The facility aims to train one million youth from Telangana by 2030.
Rythu Bharosa Scheme	 Why in news? The Telangana state Cabinet has decided to waive crop loans upto Rs 31,000 crore at one ago. Cabinet sub-committee on Rythu Bharosa to be constituted under the chairmanship of Deputy CM Mallu Bhatti Vikramarka.
	 Key Points Rythu Bharosa Scheme also known as the Farmer's Investment Support Scheme (FISS) has been

	 implemented from the year 2018-19 Kharif season to take care of the initial investment needs of every farmer. It provides Investment Support for Agriculture and Horticulture crops by way of a grant of Rs. 5,000/- per acre per farmer each season for the purchase of inputs. There is no cap on the number of acres, and most of the farmers are small and marginal. Eligibility: Must be residents of Telangana state. Must own the agricultural land Commercial farmers are not eligible under this scheme Farmers working on a rental contract or tenant farmers are also not eligible under this scheme.
Bonalu Festival	 Why in news? Telangana Chief Minister Revanth Reddy was invited to the Bonalu festival.
	 Key Points Bonalu is a Hindu Festival where Goddess Mahakali is worshiped and is celebrated usually during Ashada Masam that falls in July/August. It is an annual festival celebrated in the twin Cities Hyderabad and Secunderabad and other parts of Telangana state, India. The festival is considered as a form of thanksgiving to the



Goddess after the fulfillment of vows.
