APCNF Joint Winner of Gulbenkian Prize	Context: The Andhra Pradesh Community Managed Natural Farming (APCNF) programme, initiated by the State government in 2016, has garnered international acclaim by jointly winning the Gulbenkian Prize for Humanity 2024. This prestigious award, shared with Padma Shri Rattan Lal (USA/India) and SEKEM (Egypt), recognizes APCNF's role in promoting sustainable agriculture. Key points: Led by Rythu Sadhikaraka Samstha (RySS), APCNF operates across 500,000 hectares, impacting over a million predominantly female farmers. The programme advocates for natural farming techniques such as organic residue use, minimal tillage, indigenous seed reintroduction, and crop diversification, including agroforestry. These practices have significantly boosted yields, incomes, and nutritional security from the first season while contributing to environmental conservation by sequestering soil carbon, reversing land degradation, and promoting biodiversity. APCNF's recognition underscores its pivotal role in the global movement towards regenerative agriculture, validating its grassroots-driven approach that combines environmental sustainability with economic empowerment.
P-4 policy	Context: • Chief Minister Nara Chandrababu Naidu unveiled the P-4 policy (Public-Private-People Partnership) during a virtual address at the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) conference in Visakhapatnam.
	Key points: • This initiative aims to tackle economic disparities by encouraging the top 10% of the population to support the bottom 20% through comprehensive long, medium, and short-term plans.
	Government Initiatives and Commitments: • Highlighting the state's progress, Naidu underscored reforms in the power sector and emphasized support for

Plan for Road Construction in Andhra Villages

Context:

- The Andhra Pradesh government under the leadership of Deputy Chief Minister Pawan Kalyan plans to construct 7,213 km of roads in rural areas with an allocated budget of Rs 4,976 crore.
- This initiative aims to bolster the state's rural infrastructure, crucial for overall development.

Key points:

Government Initiative and Funding:

- The project, initiated in collaboration with the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank (AIIB), focuses on improving road connectivity to villages with populations exceeding 250.
- Since its launch in **2018-19**, the project has been pivotal in enhancing accessibility and connectivity in rural Andhra Pradesh.

Financial Arrangements:

To expedite road construction, the state government and AIIB have structured financing where the government provides a matching grant of Rs 75 crore monthly, supplemented by Rs 125 crore from the bank.


