Andhra Pradesh govt. undoes name change of NTRUHS to YSRUHS	<ul> <li>Context:</li> <li>The AP government has recently reversed its decision to rename Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences (NTRUHS) to Dr. YSR University of Health Sciences (YSRUHS).</li> <li>The university was originally named after the legendary actor and former Chief Minister, N.T. Rama Rao.</li> <li>In 2022, the state government had changed the name to honor former Chief Minister Y.S. Rajasekhara Reddy.</li> <li>However, due to various reasons, including public opinion and political considerations, the government has decided to restore the original name.</li> </ul>


