- The CAG report indicated that the state's spending exceeded its budgeted allocation, raising concerns about financial management and potential implications for the state's fiscal health.











- The Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG) is a constitutional body established by Article 148 of the Indian Constitution.
- **Appointment**: The CAG is appointed by the President of India and holds office for a term of six vears.
- **Independence:** The CAG is independent of the executive and enjoys the same security of tenure as a Supreme Court judge.
- Functions: The CAG audits the accounts of the Union and State governments, as well as public sector undertakings. Its primary role is to ensure financial accountability and prevent irregularities.
