PM-KISAN Scheme	Why in news? • Approximately 8 million farmers in Telangana benefited from the Pradhan Mantri Kisan Samman Nidhi (PM-KISAN) scheme to support the financial needs of landholding farmers.
	 Key Points: The PM-KISAN is a Central Sector Scheme launched in 2019 with 100% funding from the Government of India. It is being implemented by the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare. Objective: To provide eligible farmers with an annual financial assistance of ₹6,000. This assistance is distributed in three equal installments of ₹2,000 each every 4 months, via Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) into beneficiaries' bank accounts.

World Bank-Telangana Partnership	 Why in news? The Telangana government and the World Bank have agreed to form a cross-functional team to develop practical projects. The projects include skill development, urban revitalization, Net Zero initiatives, and improvements in citizen healthcare, diagnostics, and electronic records.
	 Key Points: The World Bank was created in 1944, as the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) along with the IMF. The IBRD later became the World Bank. It is one of the United Nations' specialized agencies. Members: 189 member countries. India is also a member country. Major Reports:

Sitarama Lift Irrigation - Launch	 Why in news? The Sitarama lift irrigation scheme was inaugurated by Telangana CM Revanth Reddy. Key Points: It is constructed at Dummugudem village in Bhadradri kothagudem District. It is the third largest biggest project after Kaleshwaram and Palmuru Ranga Reddy lift irrigation scheme. This project aims to divert Godavari river water to irrigate 2.72 lakh hectares in three districts of Bhadradri Kothagudem, Khammam and Mahabubabad districts of Telangana. It also aims to generate 280 megawatts of hydro-electric power, store 36.57 tmc ft of water, and irrigate 1.13 lakh acres in Yellandu, Pinapaka, and Wyra constituencies.

	Key findings: Comparative Lagging: Telangana lags behind its peer states in South India in terms of education. PwC recommends a higher allocation of the state budget to education.
	Issues in School Education: Decline in Reading Skills and PGI: Over the past decade, a decline in reading skills was observed among school students. The Performance Grade Index (PGI) dropped in 19 districts across the state.
	Low Budget Allocation: • Telangana has the lowest percentage of state budget allocated to education, with a continuous decline over the years. Concerns in Higher Education


