Vision 2047 document	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The state government is getting ready to release its <b>Vision 2047 document on October 2.</b></li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The draft aims to ensure that the state would become a <b>\$2-trillion economy</b> where the <b>per capita income would be \$45.</b></li> <li>It also envisages giving a <b>five-year vision document</b> for every district to achieve <b>zero poverty level, development of basic infrastructural facilities, demographic management</b> in the age group of <b>15-59 years.</b></li> <li>The draft document is being drafted with the goal of achieving a <b>growth rate of 15% per annum.</b></li> </ul>
Gram Sabha	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Andhra Pradesh government to hold village meetings in 13,326 gram panchayats (GPs).</li> </ul> <p><b>Purpose:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Identify development projects under the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS).</li> <li>Pass necessary resolutions for infrastructure development in villages.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A Gram Sabha is an <b>elected assembly of adults</b> who live in a village or group of villages and are <b>registered to vote in the Panchayat.</b></li> <li>The term Gram Sabha is defined in the Constitution of India under <b>Article 243(b).</b></li> <li>It is a <b>legal body</b> that performs legislative functions at the village level.</li> <li><b>Its functions include:</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Developing programs for the village</li> <li>Controlling funds received by the Gram Panchayat</li> <li>Promoting village development and equality</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB)	<p><b>Why in news?</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The National Crime Records Bureau has put Andhra Pradesh first in <b>food adulteration</b> cases.</li> </ul> <p><b>Key Points:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>It was established in <b>1986</b> to act as a <b>repository of information on crime and criminals.</b></li> </ul>

### Key Points:

- The **Ease of Doing Business (EoDB)** index measures the **regulatory environment in economies and its impact on business operations**, reflecting the level of ease or difficulty in starting and operating a business.
- The **EoDB report**, published by the **World Bank**, assesses economies on **ten key indicators including starting a business, dealing with construction permits, getting electricity, and registering property.**
