Polavaram Project	 Why in news? Recently, the cabinet has nodded for Rs. 12,157 crore for Polavaram project. Key Points: The Polavaram Irrigation Project is on the river Godavari near Ramayyapeta village of Polavaram Mandal, about 34 km. It is an under construction multi-purpose irrigation project on the Godavari River in the Eluru District and East Godavari District in Andhra Pradesh. This multi-purpose major irrigation potential of 4,36,825 ha. The project also envisages generation of 960MW of hydro power, drinking water supply to a population of 28.50 lakh in 611 villages and diversion of 80 TMC of water to Krishna river basin.

Reverse Tendering System	 Why in news? The Andhra Pradesh Cabinet has approved the abolition of the reverse tendering system brought in by the past YSRCP government.

	 A reverse tender, also known as a reverse auction, is a competitive procurement method where a buyer asks businesses to bid on the price of a good or service. The buyer then chooses the seller who is willing to accept the lowest price. This is the opposite of a regular auction, where the seller sets the price and buyers bid higher.
